

References and Symbols used in this Timetable

Date and Time Symbols

- a** Arrival time
- d** Departure time
- p** Previous night
- s** Stops to set down only
- u** Stops to pick up only
- x** Stops on request. Customers wishing to alight must inform the on-train staff, prior to departure from the previous station, and those wishing to join must give a clear hand signal to the driver

- M** Monday
- T** Tuesday
- W** Wednesday
- Th** Thursday
- F** Friday
- S** Saturday
- Su** Sunday

- Adding '**O**' to the abbreviation for the day or days (eg **WO**) means the train runs **only** on the day or days preceding the '**O**'
- Adding '**X**' to the abbreviation for the day or days (eg **FX**) means the train runs on all the days in this section of the Timetable **except** the day or days preceding the '**X**'

{ Wavy Line between train times indicates that this train does **not** run during the full period of the Timetable on which the train is shown
