# *Edinburgh – Glasgow 25% faster*



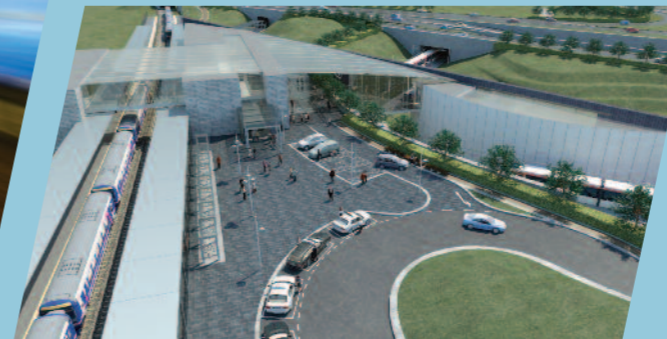
*Improving your journey - Getting you there faster.*

*Working with the Scottish Government we're making major improvements between Edinburgh and Glasgow. By 2016 we'll reduce the fastest journey time to 37 minutes and double the number of services available. This will mean you will have a faster, more frequent and more reliable service.*



### How will we do it?

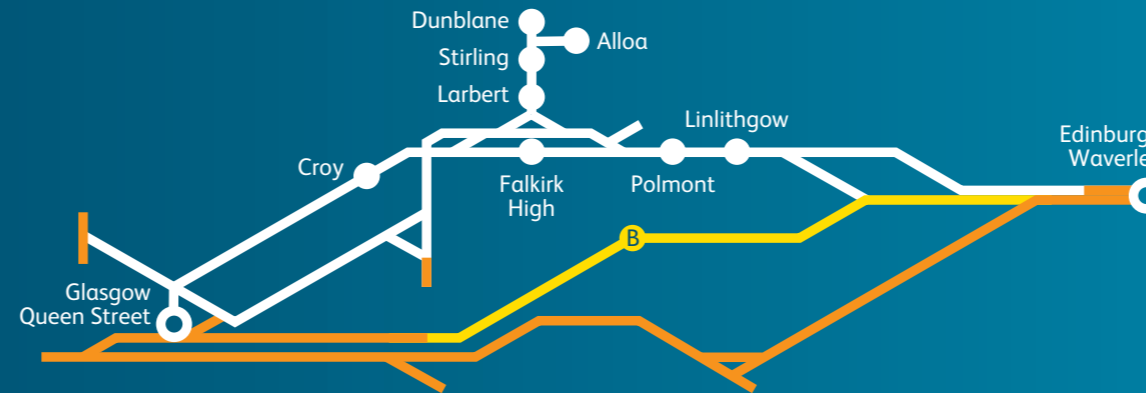
We will electrify 350km of railway and carry out associated infrastructure enhancements as part of a seven year investment programme.



### The benefits will extend across central Scotland

Benefits for business, tourism and the environment will include:

- A faster, and more frequent service between Edinburgh and Glasgow will reduce your journey time by 25 %.
- New and increased service opportunities between Alloa/Dunblane and Glasgow - reducing your journey by up to 10-minutes.
- New and increased service opportunities between Dunblane and Edinburgh - reducing your journey by up to 5-minutes.
- Additional hourly local services between Glasgow Central and Edinburgh via Shotts.
- A new rail/tram interchange station at Gogar.
- Transforming Haymarket station into modern Interchange facility.



**Route** The work will also improve journey times and increase the level of service to Stirling and Dunblane.
