Aaren,

While we can see both the logic of, and the potential benefit deriving from this proposal, to the Industry and to individual companies, it would be reassuring to see some statistical evidence regarding the accuracy of PFM, as measured against the accuracy of modelled EC4T consumption.

A slight nervousness arises, whereby PFM users acquire benefit via derived accuracy (for want of a better expression), which disadvantages those parties that are still involved in the wash-up process; I include NR in this category.

Perhaps this concern is misplaced.

However, assuming that some PFM trialling has taken place, it would be interesting and potentially reassuring to learn of the output from, and conclusions drawn from such trials, commercial confidentiality considerations notwithstanding.
