- Multi-Discipline: Likely to be split by asset type and size, i.e. reactive, minor renewals, major renewals, enhancements covering Capital Delivery & Works Delivery.
- Signalling: Likely to continue and extend current arrangements. Feeding into national discussions and see benefit in joined up national approach in this market around ETCS.
- Track: not a priority as Track contracts in place until CP8.
- OLE: NEP currently available in 'LNW N' area. Likely to be next priority after Multi Discipline pending funding decisions
- Initial CP7 engagement planned with the supply chain early 2022 and kick-off procurement in Q1 2022 subject to NR ELT & regional sign-off. PIN will be issued February 2022

- Procuring two new partnerships (South / North) for Capital Delivery that will align with the ACE operating model and cover the renewals & minor enhancements portfolios.
- 4 discipline groups per partnership: Structures/Geotechnics/Buildings, Signalling (non-ETCS) & Telecoms, Contact Systems, Distribution & Power. Multiple partners in each discipline. Each partner will contract with Network Rail and be bound by an overarching Partnering Agreement to drive collaboration, KPI-based performance and efficiencies.
- The partnership strategy aligns with the Construction Playbook, Project 13 principles and other industry models.
- Signalling & Telecoms: mainly for non-ETCS signalling renewals (partial renewals and refurbishment). Feeding into national discussion.
- Contact systems separated from the Distribution & power lot to select the right capability suppliers.
- Estimated timing to award CP7 partnership contracts before November 2023.
- Not in this procurement scope: track, major projects & programmes (MPP), works delivery renewals.

- Southern Integrated Delivery (SID) will be a fully integrated team based on 'Project 13' principles comprising all categories of railway assets: Signalling, Track, Buildings & Civils (B&C), Electrification and Plant (E&P) and Minor Works.
- All Partners will sign into a multi-party SID Agreement based on an NR21 alliance form of contract. The main SID agreement will be 10 years in duration and will commence in CP7 with the inclusion of a break clause prior to the commencement of CP8.
- The establishment of the SID will be undertaken in two tranches, the first of which was for the procurement of the Buildings & Civils and Electrification & Plant (issued 5th November 2021) the second tranche of procurement pertains to the appointment of a Signalling Business Partner and a Track Business Partner (31/01/2022 scheduled)
- Restrictions on the number of places an organisation is eligible to win across each 4 lots have been included (a maximum of one lot/discipline)

- The Digital Signalling to be procured is the following components of a European Train Control System (ETCS) Infrastructure for the GB railways network: Signalling renewals or modifications using ETCS as the primary technology (but not exclude associated conventional works); Design and build services with associated technical support and in-life support; Interlockings, control systems, lineside equipment and associated works; all "infrastructure" side; associated removals and disposal; Associated activities including but not limited to power, communications, track modifications, civils etc.; Associated data management, cyber security, technical integration; does not include TM, COMPASS, On-board works
- Specification requirements will be as flexible as possible to maximise the number of suppliers that can offer products and maximise the potential for interoperability
- A single multi-supplier Framework for the whole of Great Britain, which will maximise Network Rail flexibility to package call-off contracts.
- The contract will be based on a long-term Framework for 8 or more years (NEC4)
- Following Framework award it is anticipated that there would be two stages of delivery:
 - Stage 1 Development & Acceptance product development and assurance that it is safe, compatible, reliable, fit for purpose and do not import unacceptable risks. This stage would allow a proportion of development costs to be paid to the successful suppliers.
 - Stage 2 Design & Build call off contracts
- The Framework awards would include a guaranteed minimum share of the work to be delivered under the Framework.
- The minimum share would be determined initially at Framework award but may vary thereafter based on the delivery of value for money / cost efficiency
