

Network Rail Standards & Controls Website – External User Access (Access Package)

External Supplier Access to the new Standards & Controls website is controlled via Network Rail's EntraID (Azure) account management.

Access to the new website will be granted using your **own** organisation's EntraID (Azure) User account or your **own** email address.

You may request access via the Access Request link (Access Package) that will be published on the former website or that may have been emailed to you. Alternatively, use the following link:

The Access Request need only be completed once. It will register you on Network Rail's Entra ID account management system, after which the Standards & Controls website can be accessed via the URL advised at the end of this document. Accounts that remain inactive for 12 months will be removed.

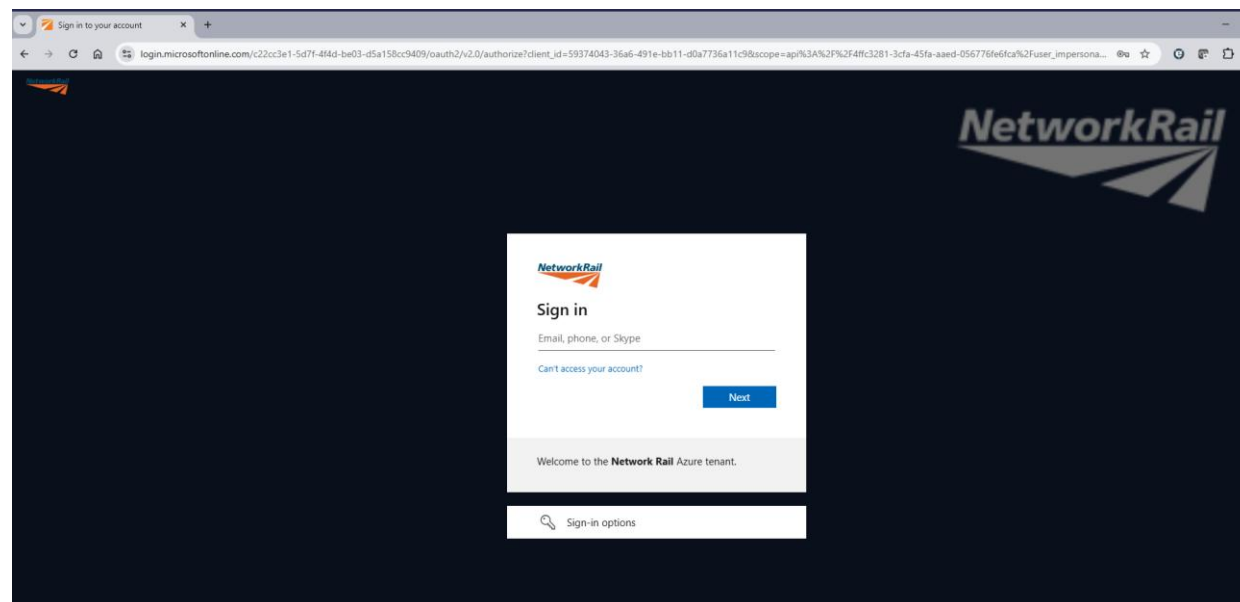
Sign In:

Use the Access Request link to access the Standards and Controls website.

You will be first prompted to sign in to **myaccess.microsoft.com** for credential verification.

Note:

Please use your own organisation's User ID or email address — **not** the Network Rail account previously issued.



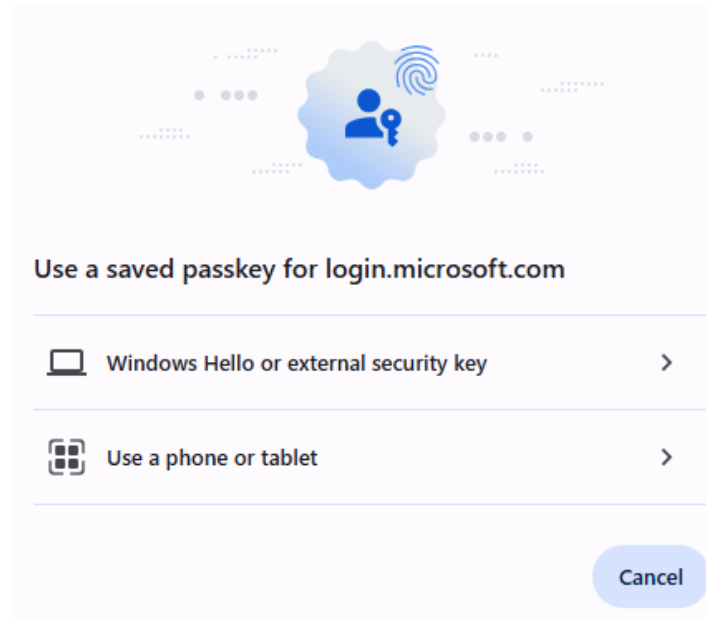
Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)

If your User ID is linked to an Azure account (EntraID), you will be prompted to authenticate using your usual multi-factor authentication (MFA) method, such as Microsoft Authenticator.

If your User ID is not associated with an Azure account, you will be asked to enter a one-time passcode (OTP) that will be sent to your email address (see the next screen).

Note:

If you have previously used Network Rail applications, you may already have Microsoft Authenticator installed. If not, you will be prompted to download and set up Microsoft Authenticator on your smart device.



One Time Passcode (OTP):

An OTP will be sent to your email.

Once received, Enter code in the Logon screen.

Click on **[Sign in]**

Note:

If you have previously authenticated with Network Rail's Azure (EntraID) account management, you may may not be prompted for an OTP.

Account Blocked

Some individuals' or organisations' email domains may be restricted by Microsoft security controls. If your account is blocked, please contact your organisation's IT team for assistance.

Access Denied

Once your Access Package has been approved, you will be notified by email and will then be able to sign in to the site. Please wait for this notification before attempting to access the website, as trying to sign in before the process is complete may result in an Access Denied message.

Signing In

There is a new way of signing in and you must use your organisation's work email address to sign in. Network Rail guest accounts issued for the previous site are not supported on the new platform.
